## 2017 New Faculty Community Engagement Tours

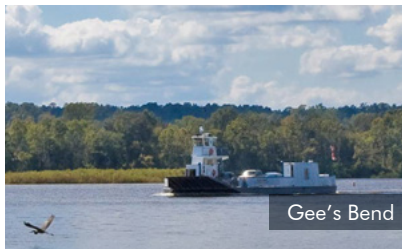
THE UNIVERSITY OF ALABAMA®

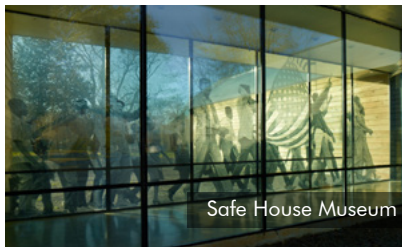

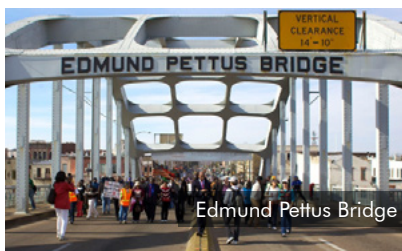
